- Strengthening collaboration for the growth of the civil society ecosystem

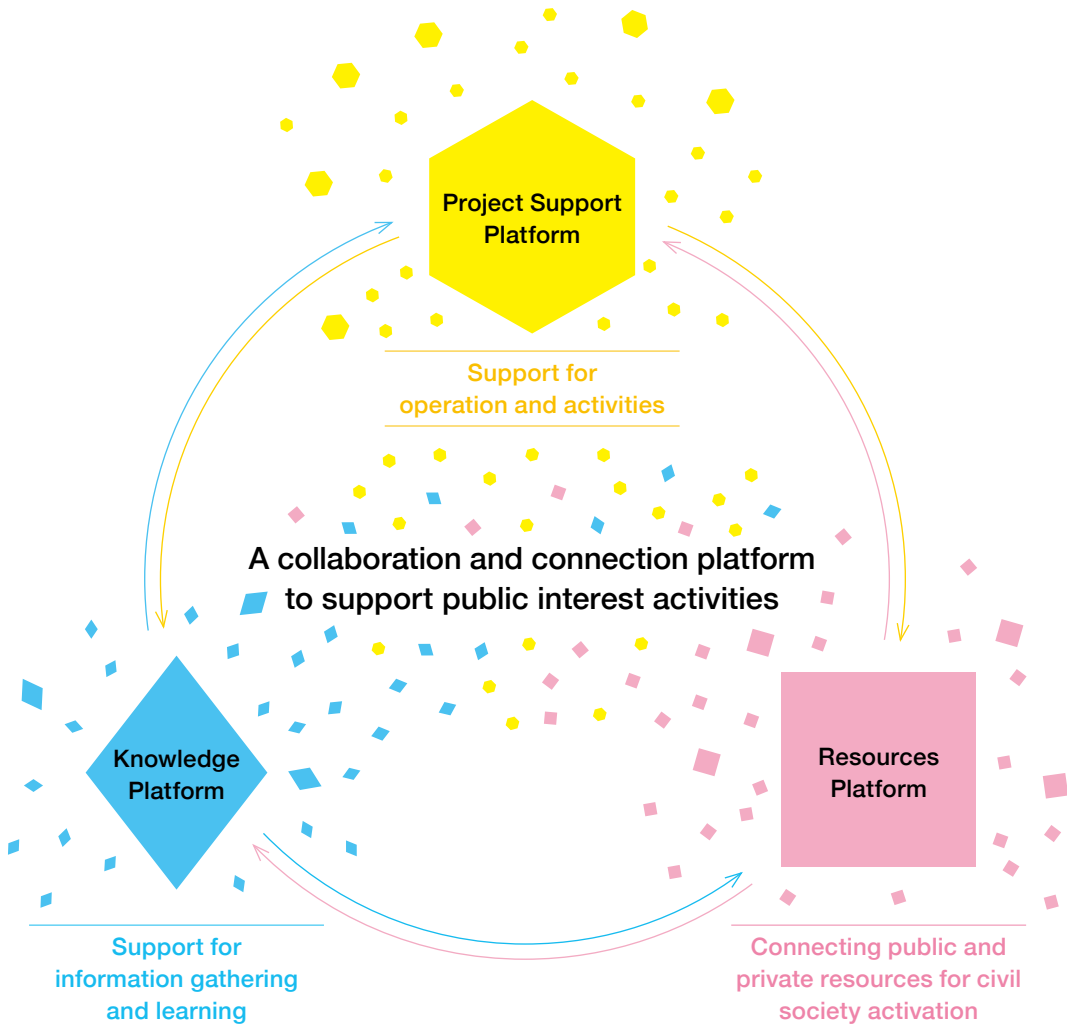
Seoul NPO Center

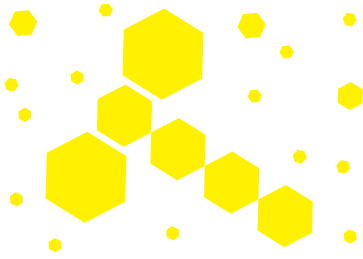
NPO

We provide tools to help organizations and activists work effectively

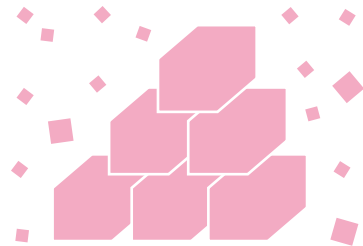
• Nonprofit startups	Public interest activity incubator

#Knowledge Platform

We help activists examine society through various types of information and knowledge and apply this understanding to their activities

• NPO Knowledge Forum	A new stimulus for activities



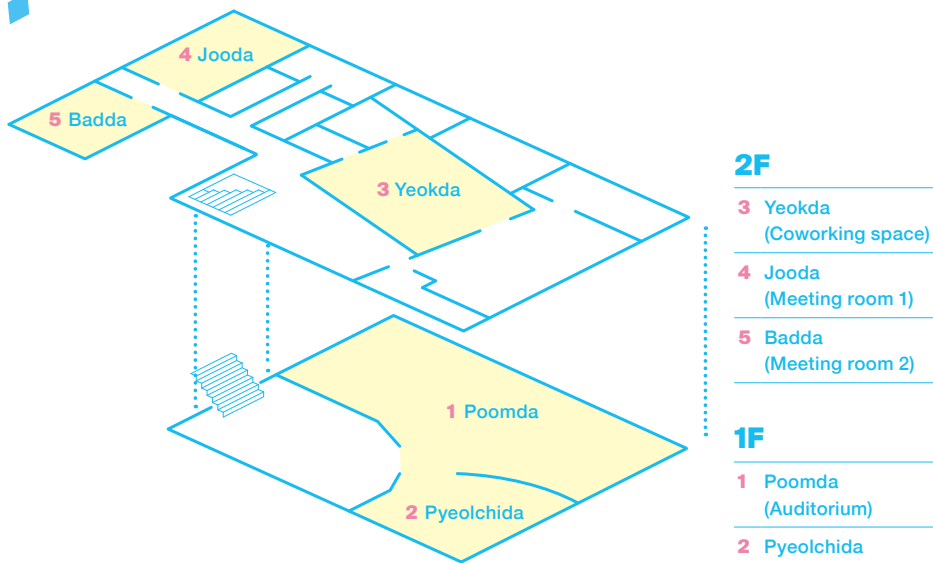
#Resources Platform

As the base for public interest activities and activists, we provide a secure space for public interest activities



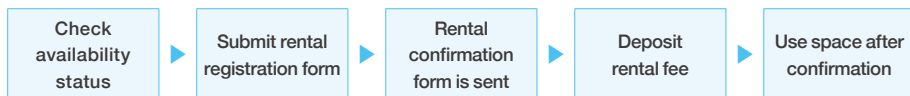
